

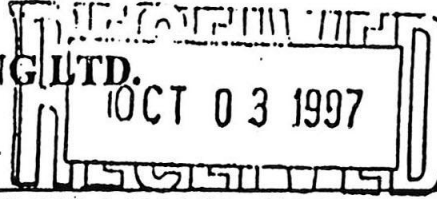

NOTICE TO MOTOR CARRIER

1. The Motor Carrier is authorized only to provide service as outlined below, and no other.
2. This document shall be carried on the vehicle and be available at all times for inspection.
3. This document must be carried with the Motor Carrier certificates bearing the same Reference No. and cancels all previous "Conditions of Licence".

**CONDITIONS OF LICENCE**

Kind of freight that may be transported

For whom freight may be transported

Area, district or territory that may be served

1. General freight.

Any individual or company.

From any inter-provincial or international boundary delivered to any point in British Columbia; or vice versa.

**NOTICE:** THIS AUTHORITY DOES NOT ALLOW THE PICK UP OF FREIGHT IN BRITISH COLUMBIA FOR DELIVERY IN BRITISH COLUMBIA UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY AN AUTHORITY ISSUED UNDER PART III OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE TRANSPORT ACT.

2. The issuance of this authority permits the movement of goods through British Columbia on a corridor basis, provided that the movement has been authorized by the jurisdiction where the goods originated.

3. General freight, excluding the transport of logs, and bulk sand, gravel, rock, earth, snow, bituminous construction material and debris from land clearing or demolished buildings.

Any individual or company.

Between points in British Columbia.
